#### **Your Arrival on Site**

- o The nearest train station is 20 miles from site. Nearest bus stop is 400yrds
- National trust visitors centre sign on main road, club sign on right hand side of road on approach to visitor centre
- Barriers locked between 7am-11pm. First arrivals after 1pm. Out of hours procedure instructions on reception door
- Approach road is tarmac
- o Overnight carpark is at the visitors centre. There is a pedestrian opening in the fence
- o There is no designated accessible parking space
- o There are no handrails leading to reception
- There are no steps

## Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed
- Opening hours for reception are 9am-10:30am and 4pm-6pm
- o For out of hours arrivals, full details are available on the reception door
- o Access to reception is level
- There is a slight lip on the reception door
- The floor is free from clutter

#### **Your Pitch**

- Cars can be parked next to units on site
- o Hardstanding pitches are available next to the accessible facility
- o Hardstanding pitches are gravel
- There are a number of level pitches close to the facility block
- There are no vehicles allowed in the tent field. So cars cannot be parked next to tents

#### **Your Facilities**

- o There is a clear well maintained path leading to the facility blocks
- There are no steps leading to the facility blocks
- There is no ramp and access is level
- o There is a semi-ambulant cubicle in the ladies but not the men's
- Taps are screw top
- The showers have seats
- Showers are push button operated
- o The showers do not have a step
- o The blocks are lit at night

#### **Your Accessible Facilities**

- o There is a flat level path leading to the accessible facility
- There are no handrails
- Access is level into the room
- The toilet has handrails
- The toilet has a large flush handle
- o Transfer space is on the right of the toilet
- The washbasin can be reached from the toilet
- Taps are lever top
- o There is a hand dryer
- o There is a full length mirror
- o The shower has handrails
- The shower is dial operated
- o The shower is open access
- o The shower is height adjustable
- o The floor is non-slip
- There is no hair dryer
- o There is an emergency chord and it can be reached from the floor
- The alarm cannot be heard from the staff pitches or reception

### **Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas**

- These areas have good level access over tarmac
- Taps are screw top
- Washing machines are front loading
- o At least one washing machine can be loaded from the floor
- o Tumble dryers are front loading
- They are stacked
- o There is a wall mounted iron
- There is a wall mounted ironing board
- o There are indoor washing up facilities
- Taps are screw top
- There is an outdoor drying area

## **Your Recreational Areas**

- o There is no indoor recreation area
- o There is no children's play area

#### Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- o There is flat level access to the refuse area
- o Path is tarmac
- o There are no steps or kerbs
- o There are no handrails leading to these areas
- o 4ft high industrial bins for general & recycling waste 2ft for glass recycling
- o There are fire triangles on site
- o There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment
- o Assembly point 1 is at the main gate. Point2 is at the rear gate
- o The surfaces are Point 1 tarmac point 2 gravel

## **Miscellaneous Information**

- o There are speed bumps on site
- Pitch areas have light from hook-up bollards wall lighting at block & reception low level lighting on paths to block
