We wanted to drop you a quick email to tell you a little bit more about our site before you arrive and we have also attached a map to help you find us.

On-site Shop

Our on site shop stocks a selection of basic food items, ice creams and camping accessories. As part of the Club's Eat Local campaign we have fresh bread delivered daily from a local baker, eggs from our own free range chickens and sausages, burgers and meat pies from the National Trust Farm on the Hardwick Hall Estate.

The site shop is the newsagents for the local area so you will be able to purchase all your daily newspapers and magazines.

Directions

From the North M1 J29, A6175 toward Clay Cross, over first roundabout, left at second roundabout towards Tibshelf. 3 miles, left at roundabout. 2 miles, left before Carnarvon Arms.

From the South M1 J28, A38 towards Mansfield, 1st lights turn left, over 2 mini roundabouts, straight through lights, left at crossroads, 2 miles, end of road turn right. 1.5 miles turn left before Carnarvon Arms.

From the East A617 from Newark, end of A617 turn right onto A38. Straight over major lights, Fox and Crown lights turn left towards Skegby, 3 miles, straight over at roundabout, down the hill and right at Carnarvon Arms.
