



A timely reminder

This information sheet is being sent to all Club Sites to remind everyone of the dangers of carbon monoxide.

The Club doesn't recommend the use of any combustion appliance (such as a gas, petrol or charcoal one) in a tent or awning unless there is an area in the unit specifically designed for it.

This is for two reasons - firstly, the fire risk and also because significant ventilation is needed for the fuel to burn completely so carbon monoxide isn't produced.

And don't forget a barbecue can be potentially lethal if brought into a tent or awning – it's definitely for use outside.
