


Under the big skies of Lincolnshire

Idyllically located in the Lincolnshire Fenlands where endless skies meet hilly countryside, our Club Site is also just a short drive from the sandy beaches of Skegness and Chapel St Leonards.

The Edwardian town of Woodhall Spa has several places to eat out, a Cottage Museum telling the history of the local community, and the Kinema in the Woods, a unique two-screen cinema, which also has an organ and opens seven days a week.

Other local attractions include Lincoln Castle and Tattershall Castle, a dramatic 15th century red brick tower managed by the National Trust.
