

Access Statement – Speyside

Your Arrival on Site

- Train station 15 miles, bus stop 2.5 miles
- Tourist information signs on main road both directions 2.5 miles from site, one blue/white camping symbol sign opposite site entrance
- Metal barriers for entry and exit closed 11pm – 7am. For out of hours ring bell at reception
- Approach road is tarmac
- There are no parking facilities, however there is enough space to park 2 cars next to the exit barrier
- New arrivals pull up on tarmac surface on slight slope
- There are no designated accessible parking spaces
- There are no handrails leading to reception
- Single step into reception

Your Check in

- Reception is clearly signed
- Opening hours are 9 - 10:30 and 16:00 – 17:00
- For out of hours please ring door bell
- No level access leading to reception
- Sloping path and one step into reception
- Once inside floor is clear from clutter

Your Pitch

- Pitches are available where cars can be parked next to a campers unit
- Hardstanding pitches are available close to the accessible facility
- Hardstanding pitches are gravel and grass
- Level pitches are available that are close to facility blocks

Your Facilities

- There is a clear, well maintained path leading to the facilities
- No steps or ramps leading to the facilities
- No semi-ambulant cubicles
- Taps are screw top
- Wall hung seats in the gents, stools in ladies
- Showers are dial operated
- Showers have a step
- Facility block is lit at night

Your Accessible Facilities

- There is a flat level path leading to the accessible facility
- There are no handrails
- There is flat level access when entering the accessible room
- The toilet has handrails
- The toilet has a larger flush
- Transfer space to the right
- The washbasin cannot be reached from the floor
- Taps are lever top
- There is a hand dryer
- A full length mirror is available
- The shower has handrails
- Shower is dial operated
- Shower is open access
- Shower head is height adjustable
- Floor is non-slip
- There is no hair dryer
- There is an emergency cord that can be reached from the floor
- The alarms can be heard from reception and the staff pitches

Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas

- These areas have good level access
- Access over paving slabs
- Taps are screw top
- Washing machines are floor level and front loading
- Tumble dryer is front loading and stacked on the washing machine
- There is no iron
- There are outdoor but undercover washing up facilities
- Sinks are screw top
- There is an outdoor drying area

Your Recreational Areas

- There is no indoor recreation area
- There is an outdoor children's play area
- Access is not flat or level
- Seating is available
- Play area surface is bark
- There is a raised edge surrounding the play area

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- No slightly sloping tarmac
- No steps or kerbs
- No handrails
- Bins are 1.2m high
- There is a fire triangle on site
- There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment
- Fire assembly point is at the top of the site
- Assembly point surface is grass

Miscellaneous Information

- There are no speed bumps on site
- Facility block and water points well lit
