## Activity Four. Wildlife explorer challenge.

**Bug hunt.**

**Bird watching.**  
Bring along a pair of binoculars and a field guide to help you spot and identify different bird species. Keep a tally of how many species you see and try to capture photos of them.

### Frogspawn discovery.

Look for ponds or marshy areas where frogs may lay their eggs. Search for frogspawn and tadpoles, observing their development stages and behaviour.
