Activity three.

Campsite treasure hunt.

Have fun getting creative and exploring the wonders of nature through these activities.

1. Build a den in the woods.

- Find a suitable location with sturdy trees or branches.
- Gather fallen branches, sticks, and leaves to construct the frame.
- Use larger branches as the base and smaller ones to fill in the gaps.
- Add a layer of leaves or moss for insulation and comfort inside.
- Make sure the den is stable and safe before enjoying your hideaway!

2. Make a daisy chain.

3. Bird nest.

- Gather materials such as twigs, grass, leaves, and feathers.
- Find a sheltered spot, preferably in a tree or bush.
- Use twigs to form the base of the nest, creating a sturdy structure.
- Weave in softer materials like grass and feathers to create a cozy lining.
- Shape the nest into a bowl-like structure, ensuring it's secure and well-hidden.

4. Grass trumpet.

- Find a long, sturdy blade of grass.
- Hold it between your thumbs and index fingers, leaving a small gap near your lips.
- Blow gently across the top of the grass blade while simultaneously squeezing your fingers together slightly.
- Adjust the tension and angle until you produce a clear, trumpet-like sound.
- Experiment with different lengths and thicknesses of grass for varied tones!



5. Bug hotel.

- Gather natural materials such as logs, sticks, pine cones, and stones.
- Stack the materials in layers to create different habitats for bugs.
- Fill gaps with leaves, straw, or other organic matter to provide insulation.
- Add features like hollow bamboo canes or drilled wooden blocks to attract solitary bees and other insects.
- Place the bug hotel in a quiet, sheltered spot and watch as it becomes a haven for all sorts of creepy crawlies!
